MAC Membership Program

Dr. Barry Knapp and his wife, Carolyn, belong to the Mercy's MAC Membership program. When he had a medical emergency last April, Carolyn dialed the Mercy Air Care's number. Within minutes, the hospital's air ambulance arrived at the couple's farm in Westfield, Iowa, and transported Dr. Knapp to Mercy's Emergency Room, some 20 miles away.

"I was unconscious at the time but the quick response by the air ambulance and its professional crew may very well have saved my life," he says. "I highly recommend the MAC Membership Program."

You can help MAC continue its lifesaving mission by joining the MAC Membership program. For a \$50 annual membership or \$1,000 lifetime membership, Mercy will bill the member's insurance company directly for any medically necessary flight and accept that reimbursement as payment in full.

MAC members may also designate 10% of their annual membership fee to emergency medical services in their community. The Foundation's 2005 Gala, "Lights of Havana," was a success in every way, setting a record for both attendance and proceeds.

"We had 460 guests attend the Gala this year," said Lea Clausen, Executive Director of the Foundation. "We would like to thank our physician partners and generous friends in the community for their continued support of this event."

Dr. Patrick and Lori Walsh were co-chairs for Gala, the Foundation's major fundraiser. Proceeds from the event benefited women and children's services at Mercy.

For an evening, guests were transported to old Havana. "Our wonderful committee worked hard to create an authentic Cuban flair for the evening. I cannot say enough about the wonderful staff of the Marina Inn who truly work their magic through the food and service."

"The menu was wonderful," said Lea. "With Cuban cuisine like vieiras ala gellega, tomato-avocado salad with lime-toasted cumin-cilantro vinaigrette, black bean soup, it was an exotic culinary experience."

The highlight of the evening was the presentation of the 2005 Dr. George G. Spellman Annual Service Award to Hospice of Siouxland and Siouxland Palliative Care. Named after a distinguished Sioux City physician who died in 2002, the Spellman Award recognizes outstanding service and dedication to the mission of Mercy by an individual or a group.

"This was the first time an organization or agency has been awarded the prestigious Spellman Award," said Lea. "By their actions and contributions to the community, Hospice of Siouxland and Palliative Care is altogether worthy to receive this distinction."

Gala Proceeds

Thanks to the generosity of the hospital's many friends who attended the 2005 Gala, the Foundation was able to distribute \$166,000 to programs and projects at Mercy and its clinics...

- ◆ \$8,803 to the Akron and South Sioux City Mercy Medical clinics to buy fetal monitors and fetal Doppler and tym panogram equipment.
- ◆ \$6,150 to Mercy Older Adult Services and Community Education to buy bone densitometry equipment to reduce the impact of osteoporosis. Community Ed received a \$1,025 grant to buy new infant/child safety and CPR mannequins for use in parent and safety classes.
- ◆ \$8,000 to Rehab to upgrade audiology equipment for infant screening.
- ◆ \$3,450 to Mercy Fertility Care Services to buy a laptop and LCD projector.
- ◆ \$15,420 for the Hereditary Cancer Prevention Program's "Legacy of Hope."
- ◆ \$6,000 to the Family Birth Center for a IClintek 500US analyzer and \$8,150 for a monitor that allows for continuous reading of the oxygen and carbon dioxide values in an infant's blood stream.
- ◆ \$6,270 to Rehab's Speech Pathology to buy software used in pediatric speech and language therapies and \$3,500 for materials for the pediatric program. Peds was awarded \$28,000 for new videostrobe equipment for the hospital's Voice Clinic.
- ◆ Gifts totaling \$2,820 for Sioux City and South Sioux City Mercy clinics to buy toys for their waiting rooms.
- ◆ \$48,500 to Peds for a cardiac monitor. Peds and the Family Birth Center received \$450 for portable baby swings.
- ◆ \$450 to the Child Advocacy Center to buy magazines and educational materials for children and families.
- ◆ \$10,770 to Mercy Home Care to buy infant apnea monitoring equipment for home infant monitoring.

Alliance for Women's Health

The Foundation's Alliance for Women's Health is Siouxland's first philanthropic giving circle. Its goals are to increase awareness of women's health issues and improve the well-being of women in all phases of health, mental, social, environmental and spiritual.

Through annual grants, the Alliance supports programs and services of nonprofit organizations in Mercy's 33-county service area. Grant recipients in 2005 and the amount they received were:

- ◆ The Siouxland Emergency Services program of The Center, \$1,291, for its "Healthy Woman Project-FAST" that makes it possible for women to obtain doctor-prescribed medication in emergency situations.
- ◆ The Jackson Recover Center, \$19,300, for its "Holistic Woman Project" designed to give female patients the knowledge to live addiction-free lives while it addresses their holistic health needs.

Spirit of Mercy Fund

The Spirit of Mercy Fund, supported by voluntary staff contributions, makes available an annual tax-free grant of up to \$1,000 to any eligible employee or volunteer of Mercy hospitals or clinics who needs emergency cash because of unforeseen medical emergencies or a personal tragedy.

Since its inception in 2003, the fund has benefited more than 80 people and given away more than \$100,000.

The Employee Giving Campaign raised \$45,000 for much needed improvements to the Family Waiting Room in Mercy’s Intensive Care Unit. The ICU used the money to buy new furniture, wall coverings and add a kitchenette to the waiting area.

Mercy staff contributed \$40,000 to the United Way Campaign. “The generosity of Mercy staff is truly outstanding,” said Lea Clausen, executive director of the Foundation. “I’m so proud of how they responded to real needs both at Mercy and in the larger community.”

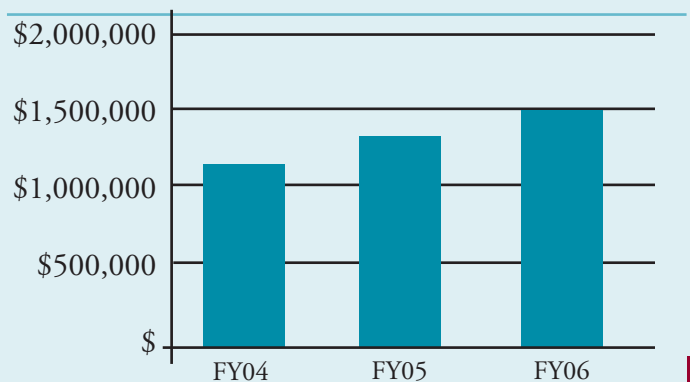

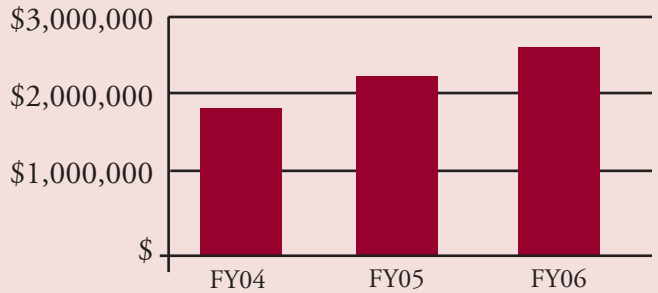

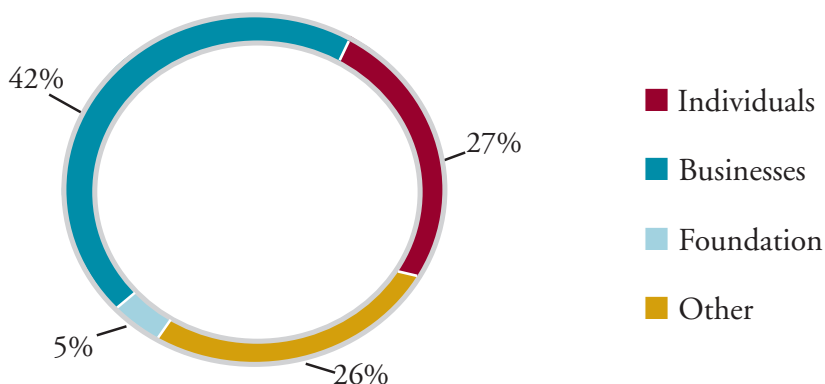

Ways of Giving

Cash

Most gifts in the form of cash and pledges over a period of years.

Securities and Other Assets

Stocks, bonds, real estate, artwork and other real property can be appropriate gifts.

Bequest

Money or property left by will to the Foundation as a specific amount or as a percentage of estate assets.

Charitable Gift Annuity

Money or property irrevocably transferred to the Foundation in exchange for an annual payment for life of a fixed-dollar amount to one or more persons.

Charitable Remainder Trust

A gift agreement where an annual payment to the donor is fixed (known as an annuity trust) or where the payment is a percentage of the trust assets (known as a unitrust). At the end of a term of years or life, the principal goes to the Foundation.

Charitable Lead Trust

A principal amount given to the Foundation and only the earnings are used for a period of up to 10 years. The principal then is returned to the donor.

Farm or Residence of Life Estate

A farm or residence is donated and the donor continues living on the property and uses it for life.

Life Insurance

A paid-up, whole-life policy given to the Foundation, which is designated as a partial or sole beneficiary. The donor realizes tax benefits when the Foundation is the owner and beneficiary of the policy.

Revocable Trust

An agreement that may be recalled by the donor during life but which becomes irrevocable at the time of death.
