## Objectives:

- Recognize the inconsistencies in the way the criminal justice system deals with children as victims and offenders.
- Identify some of the intervention problems created by not recognizing the reality of children as human beings with needs, wants, and desires to learn to manipulate their environment.

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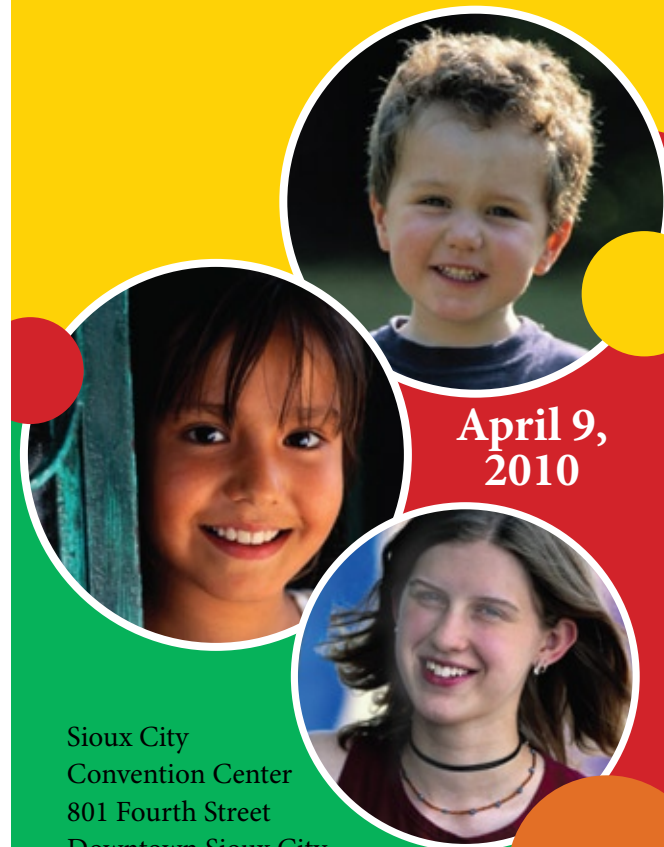

**Course Description:** This conference is designed to provide information about compliant child victims, and the dynamics of the acquaintance child molester and prevention of child abuse.

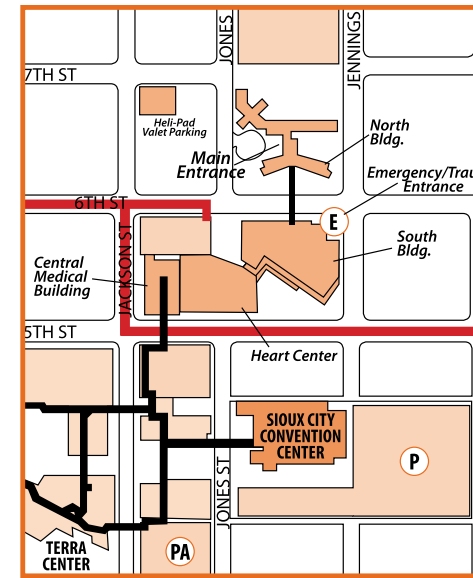
## Faculty:

**Kenneth V. Lanning**, consultant in the area of crimes against children. He was a Special Agent with the FBI for more than 30 years and specialized in the study of the sexual victimization of children. He is currently a consultant on cases involving deviant sexual behavior, the sexual victimization of children, missing and exploited children, and the use of computers and the Internet to facilitate the sexual exploitation of children. Mr. Lanning is a founding member of the Board of Directors of the American Professional Society on the Abuse of Children (APSAC) and a former member of the APSAC Advisory Board. Mr. Lanning was the 1997 recipient of the FBI Director's Annual Award for Special Achievement for his career accomplishments in connection with missing and exploited children, and the 2009 recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award for Outstanding Service from the National Children's Advocacy Center.

**Gregg Tyler Milligan** is a survivor of child abuse, who's personal history reflects a pattern of significant hardships followed by accomplishments. Author of *A Beautiful World*, Gregg tells his story of himself as a small boy who escapes the physical, emotional, and sexual abuse of a vicious mother - he finds his love for her, yet the effects of his past will ever remain. *A Beautiful World* was written not only for the millions of abused, but for all of us who refuse to give up in a weary and sometimes beautiful world.
